



Reliability Test

To achieve an accreditation that will allow you to use the Reflective Functioning Scale for clinical and research purposes you need to successfully complete the Reliability Test.

If you want the accreditation you will receive the Reliability Test zip file containing 15 Adult Attachment Interviews and instructions at the end of your training.

What you can expect after the Reliability Test

On successful completion of the Reliability Test you will:

- > Receive statistical feedback on your work.
- > Receive a certificate that attests that you have successfully passed the Reliability Test
- > Be authorised to use the Reflective Functioning Scale for clinical or research purposes.

If your feedback shows that you need more practice you will:

- > Receive written feedback on your work.
- > Receive some new transcripts chosen specifically to help you to strengthen your RF skills and enable you to feel more confident.
